WHO WE ARE

ActionAid Tanzania is a development agency that is committed for social justice, gender equality and ending poverty. It started development programs in the country on 1998 and later transformed itself into full-fledged Country Programme in 2000.

It is a registered organization in the country under the Companies Act 2002 and an Associate member of the ActionAid International Federation which is a global justice organization working to achieve social justice, gender equality and eradication of poverty. In terms of governance, it has a National Board and General Assembly while the day to day functions are managed by the Country Director and the Senior Management Team.

ActionAid Tanzania is known for its deep-rooted interventions that empower people living in poverty and works with Community Based Organizations, partners and stakeholders at local and national level to tackle the root causes of poverty and injustice and hold decision makers to account for the realization the needs and rights of people. Its grassroots programs are primarily implemented directly by communities, their organizations and local partners and stakeholders while national programs involve networks, coalitions, forums and national and international organization with a facilitative role of the organization.

Courage of Conviction, requiring us to be creative, bold and innovative – without fear of failure in pursuit of making the greatest possible impact on the causes of poverty, injustice, and gender inequality

Independence from any religious or party-political affiliation

Humility, recognising that we are part of a wider alliance against poverty and injustice

PROGRAM PRIORITIES

Goal:

Social justice, gender equality and accountability achieved by shifting power and redistributing resources and the rights of people living in poverty and exclusion advanced

While striving to meet this overarching goal, we are focusing on promoting three interconnected and mutually re-enforcing pillars: **Rights, Redistribution and Resilience.** All interventions aim at promoting the rights of people living in poverty, redistribution of power and resources and developing peoples' resilience.

HOW WE DO

ActionAid Tanzania supports & facilitates actions so that people living in poverty:

- Analyse and reflect condition and causes of poverty and inequalities and how these are linked with their rights
- Initiate, strengthen and use their agency, power and knowledge individually or collectively to influence institutions of power that perpetuates poverty and injustices
- Hold government institutions accountable on their responsibilities and claim wider space for civic engagements and participation in governance & decision making processes that affect their lives
- Take active part in and influence national and international policy processes through engaging in advocacy and campaigns at various levels
- Build solidarity and alliances with civil society organisations, social movement and other relevant actors in addressing social justice, gender equality and ending poverty

FUNDING

ActionAid Tanzania solicits funding from two major sources: Child sponsorship which is based on individual supporters from UK, Italy, Greece, Sweden and Brazil and income from institutional and high value donors, foundations and governments through preparing and selling concept notes and proposals.




WHERE WE WORK

ActionAid Tanzania has development programs in the mainland Tanzania and Zanzibar. At local level, it has long term commitment in selected district-based Local Rights Programs where it works directly with communities and local partners in Mafia, Unguja, Pemba, Kilwa, Tandahimba, Newala, Chamwino and Singida.

Moreover, it also supports governance and accountability programs in various parts of the country where it works in partnership with Youth Partnership Countrywide (YPC), Tanzania Youth Vision Association (TYVA) & AFNET. Its strategic partners consist of networks, coalitions, forums such as Agricultural Non – State Actors Forum (ANSAF), Policy Forum, Tanzania Education Network (TEN/MET) etc. that have wider outreach to communities and have national level policy advocacy engagements.

ActionAid Tanzania promotes working in partnership with organisations that share common vision and principles and has an elaborate partnership policy. The realization of promises made in the Country Strategy Paper is facilitated through engagement with community based organizations, local and national partner organizations and government stakeholders.
