ActionAid Tanzania (AATZ) is an affiliate member of the ActionAid International Federation, a global force working with women, men, and children living in poverty and exclusion to find solutions to alleviate poverty and injustice. AATZ has been operating in Tanzania since 1998 as a cross-border initiative by ActionAid Kenya and later transformed into a full-fledged Country Program in 2000. We started our operations in Zanzibar in year 2001. Since then, we have rolled out four country strategy papers that have contributed to the overall development of the country. AATZ is registered in the Tanzania Mainland and complied with the Zanzibar Society Act no 6 of 1995. AATZ is represented at the ActionAid International Assembly.

Job Title: Climate Justice and Disaster Preparedness Inspirator

Job Role:

• The purpose of this placement is to strengthen the capacity of the partners, young people, and communities in the area of Climate Justice, humanitarian, and Disaster Preparedness.

Key Responsibilities

- Build capacity of partners, young people and communities on green development models and green jobs
- Support in organizing trainings on climate justice, vulnerability assessment, disaster preparedness and to support preparations of disaster preparedness plan.
- Support to provide leadership training to localized youth hubs, youth mobilization skills and social movement building.
- Support in mobilizing youths to take active participation in climate justice campaigns and advocacy at regional and district levels.
- Support in organizing district and regional forums to youths, host communities and other key stakeholders on climate justice and disaster preparedness.
- Facilitate training to partners and youths on HRBA for programing youths related interventions for sustainability.

Essential experience:

- At least three years' professional experience in climate justice and Natural resources Management related works
- Experience in working with young people.
- Project Management experience, especially from voluntary work, will be an added advantage.
- Vulnerability and Disaster Preparedness experience especially in disaster prone areas e.g. host communities around refugees' camps.
- Human Rights Based Approach and other participatory tools and methodologies.
- Ability to provide advice in gender equality, women's rights, and women's empowerment.
