The Organisation was founded in 2018 by 20 Young people who used to work with ActionAid Local Right Program in Pemba and officially registered in Feb 2019 with the aim to support and demanding for the rights of young people in Pemba and to build capacity, sensitize youth on sustainable development, and ensure that the voice of a young people is heard across decision-making platforms and bodies in the government. 
